Who we are:

About the job:

We are seeking highly motivated, enthusiastic and skilled volunteers to work within our team. The volunteer caretakers will assist and support young adults hosted in our project that are coming from shelters and safe zones for unaccompanied minors.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Support the social worker with daily needs and individual case plans for an assigned number of hosted individuals.
- Facilitate hosted individuals community engagement through educational, social and recreational programs/activities.
- Establish a positive relationship with hosted individuals to reinforce the provision of daily support and their socioeconomic integration.
- Provide support to young hosted individuals in developing life skills, daily problem-solving and communication skills.
- Communicate regularly with Social Worker and Program Coordinator on incidents, achievements and challenges.
